Current Conditions

- Constructed in 1970s / Approx. 2,500 sq. ft. of surface area
- Approximately - 160 swimmers / 115,000 gallons of water
- (1) One 12' Dive Board, 6' Concrete Deck, 1,400 SF Sitting Area, 900 sq. ft. Concession/Restroom
- Pool Assessment Performed in 2015 by Waterscape Consultants, Inc. (Information available at City Hall)

Proposed Project

- Would address issues identified by the Pool Assessment
- Approximately 5,000 sq. ft. of surface area
- Accommodate up to 330 swimmers
- Approximately 110,000 gallons of water
- 1,400 sq. ft. kiddie play area - This would be able to support about 25 to 30 kids playing at once
- 2400 sq. ft. splash pad - Approximately 30 spray devices . This splash pad will support 40 to 50 users
- Meets minimum requirements for International Swimming Pool Code and Public Swimming Pools
